Derry City and Strabane District Council have been encouraging Community Groups, Youth Groups, Farmers and Businesses in the Strabane Area to take part in this year's Celebrations for Hallowe'en by creating Hallowe'en Themed Hay Sculptures that will form part of a Hallowe'en Trail at this year's festival.

Last year saw visitors and locals driving around the district as spooky figures emerged from the landscape including over sized spiders, bats, aliens and skeletons.

Students studying on the joinery and early years courses at the NWRC Strabane Campus launched the Hay Sculpture Project with St. Catherine's PS on 8th September in support of National Literacy Day. The project is designed to help celebrate the National Literacy Trust's 25
